

## Day-to-day program Dutch Language and Culture for Interpreters (L74)

30 July - 3 August 2018 (1 week)

*This intensive one-week course is especially designed for interpreters and translators. The course focuses on general Dutch language, culture and contemporary issues in Dutch society. The goal of the course is upgrading the interpreters' passive knowledge of Dutch through lectures on topical issues, as well as improving their active command of the Dutch language (C-level).*
